## Instructions:

Most classes are divided into lessons and exams. Most of the lessons are divided into three sections: *Read*, *Think*, and *Write*. (The few classes that are set up differently contain specific instructions.)

- The *Read* section assigns portions of textbooks, portions of scripture, and/or a graphic for you to read/study. You are strongly encouraged to do all of the reading in this section before going on.
- The *Think* section gives more information on the topic of the lesson.
- The *Write* section asks questions or assigns an essay.

Halfway through some classes is a mid-term exam, and at the end of most is a final exam. You should complete an entire class before returning your lessons and exams to AIM for grading. If you are having trouble with any lesson, please feel free to contact us to ask for help. Written assignments and exams should be emailed to us for grading. Make sure that any assignments and exams you email us are properly identified. Examples:

Basic Christian Doctrine, Lesson 1

Church Administration, Final exam

This makes it much easier for us to grade, because we won't have to guess what class and lesson we're looking at!

Finally, we recommend that you begin each lesson with prayer for guidance. Remember the words of Proverbs 23:23 in your search for knowledge:

*“Buy the truth, and sell it not;  
also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding.”*

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
